Minutes of the Halton & District meeting held at Pavilions 2nd October 7.30pm all clubs were in attendance except: Cronton Villa, Grangeway Hotshots, Halton Villa, Heath Utd, Helsby, St Michaels and Upton. Apologies were from Carole Gleave and Jackie Feeley from the Committee.

The meeting was opened by the Chairman thanking all for attending the meeting and asked had you signed in. The Chairman also pointed out that some clubs were coming in to the room emptying the folder and signing in and leaving before the meeting had even started and told the floor this was not acceptable as you are basically not attending the meetings. Please leave the folders at the end of the meetings, in them tonight are the fixtures but please always look at the web and if need be contact Mike or Dave for clarification.

1. Minutes of the last meeting: Were passed as true and correct.

1.1. Matters arising: None

2. Finance: Jane White told the floor the current figure was £15,526.05p some club deposits are included in this of £800.00 monies are still coming in for League fee's etc. Leaving a total of £14,726.05p

3. Registrations: Carole asked that people do not call her after 7.00pm and she does not do League Registration etc on Saturdays and Sundays.

4. Teamsheets: Jackie asked to remind clubs that she will only accept the teamsheets via the post not through her door please remind all your Managers.

Ste Armstrong is doing Mini Soccer you can go his home with them but avoid school times as you wont get parking. He also works nights so don't knock just put them through his door. We hope to put a sample copy of teamsheets on the web for you to look at. Both 11-aside and Mini soccer teamsheets must be received by the Thursday after your weekend game the teamsheets can now be down loaded from our web site. You can copy a teamsheet with the kids names on and venue etc but the kids signatures must be original on the day.

Welfare officers: Julie told the floor that the clubs who submitted some of the Charter criteria will be contacted by their county to follow up on the rest of it needed. Some level 1 courses will be coming up but wont be subsidised.

Welfare officers and Secretaries will have to attend the Respect presentation by Trevor Massey and we will let you know the date. The packs will be given to the clubs on the night. The Referee's Respect meeting is the 16th October at Pavilions.

5. Mini Soccer: Mike had nothing to say, a question was raised about u7's and u8's non fulfilments and the floor was told that will come up in A.O.B

6. 11-aside: Dave said if you have entered the District cup or Cheshire cup/Liverpool cup we need to know if you are in our League and are the home team drawn in the District u12's, u14's, u16's it will be a Saturday so you will get the postponement but you must write and inform us of the date etc. In the u16's District cup you will not be able to play your older lads if you have any from the u17's age in your team. The Cheshire cup is a Sunday so you wont get the postponement until the later stages.

identify them.If you could e-mail or ring if they are not coming as we waste time every year waiting for clubs to attend and they send no one at all and we could bring other teams time forward.

A.O.B We are putting on the agenda for next month as an SGM so the meeting will be starting at 7.15pm and you will receive two agenda's to download it regards u7's and u8's as non competitive football,there is some confusion on non fulfilments so we have received guidance as to this and will deal with it at the Special Agm where we will put forward an amendment on the 6th November at 7.15pm.
