Minutes of the Halton & District meeting held at Pavilions 6th November 7.30pm all clubs were in attendance except: Athena, Beechwood, Bridge Athletic and Sporting Rangers.

The meeting was opened by the Chairman thanking all for attending the meeting and asked had you signed in, make sure if you were present for the Earlier SGM that you do sign the two different signing in sheets.

1. Minutes of the last meeting: Were passed as true and correct.

1.1. Matters arising: None

1.2 The Everton Lottery presentation is to be rescheduled for the December meeting.

2. Finance: Jane White told the floor the current figure was £15,486.48p some club deposits are included in this of £800.00 leaving a total of £14,686.48p. There was a question asked by Albright regarding his level 1 cheque and was told we will come to that in correspondence later.

3. Registrations: Carole asked that people do not call her after 7.00pm and she does not do League Registration etc on Saturdays and Sundays. However suspensions that need to be deposited can be.

4. Teamsheets: Jackie asked to remind clubs that she will only accept the teamsheets via the post not through her door please remind all your Managers. This is the last time she will ask.

She said that managers must put fee down for the Referee even if it is not paid and make sure they are received by the deadline, if you post them on a Monday they should be on time anything after Monday may be late and will incur a fine. Also you must get whoever Referee's the game to put their name and signature and if possible in brackets who they are i.e Manager, parent, spectator.

Welfare officers: Julie told the floor that the clubs who submitted some of the Charter criteria to Cheshire were contacted by their county to follow up on the rest of it needed. Some level 1 courses will be coming up but won't be subsidised.

Liverpool County have informed me that Sundowner and St Basils have now been awarded the charter mark so well done, Ronnie Reason from Liverpool FA asked me to arrange a level 1 and had 23 people to go on it to work towards charter mark it was organised and then only 14 came forward so it has been postponed by them until more come on it, it needs at least 6 more people from their clubs to ensure the level 1 is to go ahead at the previous price and he prefers it to be at a later date, as of now only 2 more have come forward, so it may not be run as we have had to cancel the venue and all those who have left cheques see me at the end to see whether you want us to hold on to it a bit longer to see if more come forward. Cheshire FA will be running one soon for its members to ensure they meet Charter status. Most likely dates Jan/Feb.

Welfare officers and Secretaries attended the Respect presentation by Trevor Massey and the respect packs were given out.

5. Mini Soccer: Mike asked to see Sporting Rangers and Runcorn Panthers after the meeting.

6. 11-a-side: Dave said u11's postponed games will be added to the end of the season. Any teams in the County/District cup we still need to be notified. Website the FA will be altering their fulltime site in January, and want you to make use of the new site and you can ask them about this or call Dave.

7. Referee's Secretary: David Seddon said tell your Managers that in the u17's it is not roll on roll off so stop asking the Referee's to do this and we will be looking to see if this is happening, David is not available after tonight until Monday any problems ring Julie. A question was asked by the floor can u7's be appointed Referee's if any are available and the reply was if they are available they can do it but it is really up to each club to send someone on a team leader course to do this each week. The new up dated mini soccer rules state you cannot score straight from the kick off they can be found on the web site.

8. Runcorn & District Fa Rep: Julie said its already been discussed earlier.

9. Correspondence: Albright u11's have a new kick off time of 12.00pm not 10.30am.

Respect meeting took place and the packs were given out and could you get the forms that are for the spectators to sign and officials and players and photo copy them and send it to your county so they can put it in your file, the code of conducts for respect are in conjunction with your own code of conducts and we are getting some reports of bad lines this will not be tolerated so stop this kind of behaviour. We will have no hesitation bringing your club in if its reported, if it has gone to your county first we will also deal with you after.

Please sign up to the banner scheme its good to display positive messages and getting sponsers as well. Its £50 for the membersio which includes the 4 banners once you have done that then you can look for sponsers but please no pubs,betting shops etc it is kids football.

A memo has come through asking that teams are training on other peoples pitches and with the bad weather this must stop in particular Woodside playing fields so don't train there if it is not your pitch,the adults have to pay over £300 for them pitches so its not fair that juniors are training there.John Swain reminded clubs that parking is a problem still at the Heath Park and we do have permission to park in the Heath Buisness park a little further up on the left so please use it.

Jane asked to see some clubs at the end.
