The minutes of the Halton & District Junior League meeting held at the Pavilions on 2nd July at 8pm. All clubs were in attendance except: Athena, Bridge Ath, Cronton Villa, Dragons, Halton Villa, Heath Ath, Heath Park, Inter Union, Moorfield, Rockets, Sporting Rangers, St Basils, Sundowner, Upton, Windmill Hill Dragons and Wolves.

The chairman welcomed all to the meeting and asked had you all signed in and was there only 2 delegates per club.

1. Minutes of the last meeting: There was no minutes of the last meeting as it was the AGM.

1.1 Matters arising: The floors permission was asked for accepting late entries to the League and the floor agreed we could accept late entries, a club had arrived tonight Westgarth United and Dominic told the floor a bit about the team entering an u13's and where they are based in Prescot he was asked to leave the room and the floor voted and the club was duly elected in.

2. Finance: Jane White told the floor there was £13,131.03p but £750 club deposits are included and the invoices for best sports still have not been received yet so that needs to come out of the total.

3. Registrations: Carole Gleave told the floor that she has put guidelines in all folders please stick to it as she will be strict, please don't use staples on forms etc, always phone her first for an appointment. All Registrations forms have been given to clubs so please start bringing them in even if you only have a couple. Any extra forms needed can be downloaded from the web site but these will incur a £1 processing fee once returned to Carole and will say on them Download.

4. Team sheet co-ordinators: Jackie Feeley & Jason Bate:

Jackie Feeley is doing the mini soccer sheets this year and they will be postal only through the mail and her home address is where they will be going this will be on the sheets. We will be doing a new scoring system for fair play for u7's & u8's so please score fairly, it will be for the team, the managers, and the spectators. 11-aside will be done by Jason Bate and again they will be postal only through the mail and his home address will be on sheets, please note both members will not allow anyone to come to the house with the sheets if this does happen the club will be dealt with and may be fined.

4.1 Welfare officers Julie Cole & Jackie Feeley: All Welfare officers are now being asked to attend the Welfare Officers Workshop and Cheshire FA are telling me there is 7 clubs from Cheshire who need this doing so please get on the course.

5. Mini soccer fixture Secretary Mike gave his apologies he is on holiday and asked for his thanks to be passed to all clubs who sent him condolences when his mum passed away.

6. 11 Aside fixtures Secretary & Web site Dave Wilson asked that you get your number of teams in as quick as you can so he can start to enter them in the system and know how many we have, Hale asked was he keeping one big division or splitting Dave replied it depends on numbers of teams entering. He did say he would be looking at various ways. Although you may not have your council pitch allocation back let Dave know where and what time you applied for.

Julie also told the floor that this information needs to be in quickly as it delays the fixtures and handbook also teams need to remember it is up to them to ensure their pitch is fit and available as Mike and Dave have no control over fixtures its done by the FA full time system and depends on pitch allocation also. Look on our web for the new rules in a version of the handbook that will be going out, some FA standard code of rules have also changed this year.

7. Referee's Secretary David Seddon said Referee's are still applying and we have about 30 back up to now, Julie asked all teams from outside the area to try and get a couple of registered Referee's to call us to maybe go on our panel and cover some of their games. Dont forget you must confirm by Tuesday 8pm for weekend games and by Friday 8pm for the following mid week games.

Arthur (Heath Rangers) asked if a Referee does not return your call or you cant get hold of them when trying to confirm what can we do, the reply was call and tell David you have tried, if its on e-mail copy David him in and if the Referee does not show on the day put it in writing to the Referee's Secretary and Julie Cole.
