The minutes of the Halton & District Junior League meeting held at the Pavilions on 10th September at 8pm.

All clubs were in attendance except: Woolton.

The chairman could not attend tonight so the Treasurer Jane White welcomed all to the meeting and asked had you all signed in and was there only 2 delegates per club.

1. Minutes of the last meeting: They were passed as true and correct.

1.1 Matters arising: None

Colin Keam Runcorn & District Fa Referee's Secretary told the floor that there will be some Referee's Mentors going to matches in our League to help the young Referee's please don't abuse them they will have ID badges soon, they can also report any bad lines etc to the League and the District and we will pass it on to county.

2. Finance: Jane White told the floor there was £17,794.03p but deposits are included there was no questions for Jane.

3. Registrations: Carole Gleave is on holiday and whilst she is away Jackie and Julie will do the Registrations however you will have to phone Jackie 01928 773919 for an appointment as it will be based at her home.

4. Team sheet co-ordinators: Jason Bate & Mike Galbraith: Jason for 11-aside said please only send teamsheets through the postal service do not come to his home, he did tell you all this last time so please no more posting them yourselves, please tell all Managers and be careful filling in teamsheets, this week we have given one week's grace but next week we will expect them correctly. Mike for mini soccer also asked not to go to his home with them only through postal service also, again a lot of mistakes, where it asks for League or cup it must have correct information in for League games for u7's write League, u8's Best Sports, u9's League, u10's Rocksavage Power League, pass this on to Managers as fines will be issued next week if this is missing, Mike asked to see some clubs at the end of the meeting.

4.1 Welfare officers Julie Cole & Jackie Feeley: Alan from Cromwell had an issue regarding a young man 25-28 yrs old hanging around his training Scruffy, dark hair please be vigilant and report anything you feel to your club, County and even police. Crb's now need completing for all Managers and assistants etc me and Jackie have done this for you for 18 months and now we want your club Welfare officer to start the process so any new CWO who don't know how call us and we will show you one and then you can do the rest, please don't ignore this as it is mandatory soon and your club will come unstuck if all are not done soon.

4.2 Charter League: Dave Wilson & Julie Cole: Dave told the floor we should get the award very soon and the County will be monitoring clubs behaviour to ensure they keep the charter mark, they may also come to a training session, the FA are hoping to reduce the size of mini soccer and even encourage us to go to 9V9 for u11's so expect changes next year.

5. Mini soccer fixture Secretary Mike will be doing the draws now for the Leagues for mini soccer and will e-mail them out tomorrow. Two volunteers from the floor were asked for and Ste (Halton Villa) and Alan (Cromwell) drew home and away, then Jan (Heath Park) and Kerry (Runcorn Panthers) drew home and away.

6. 11 Aside fixtures Secretary & Web site Dave Wilson asked that if you want to send in match reports get them to him but please remember they must be fair and do not slate the Referee or opposition and Julie reminded the floor we will monitor clubs web sites also. The League will be running an u17's league next season so hopefully all our u16's now will stay and the County will help us promote this, we would also be aiming to get an all girls League at a central venue maybe on a Sunday so please pass this information on. Ste from Halton Villa asked can he put an extra team in u13's as Halton Sports have folded and turned up at his training Dave Wilson said see him at the end.

7. Referee's Secretary David Seddon could not be here tonight but said Referee's are not being confirmed so make sure this is done also if you do confirm and they don't turn up tell us so we can ask the Referee why? Clubs said they have not got numbers for some Referee's Julie said she will take this up with David, also some clubs said they can't get hold of David or Anthony Julie told the floor Anthony is not the assistant Refs Secretary this year and David does do 12 hour shifts but if you can't get the Referee or David then try Julie. There are no guarantees we can replace the Referee if it's late Thursday night/Friday.

Handbooks will have all new details in and they are going to print so please e-mail Dave Wilson with any final changes now. Julie asked does anyone need to go on the mailing list for minutes only in case they don't have e-mail, Les Hughes from St. Basils, John Tofts and Mayfield said they need postal minutes.

8. Runcorn & District FA Rep Julie Cole said nothing to report.

9. Correspondence: Julie gave out to the floor the sad news that Mr Arthur Hampson sadly passed away on this week, we have sent flowers to Cath and family Arthur was Mr Football to a lot of people and he held many a position in the League including Chairman, President and Life member, the funeral is at Holy Spirit Church 8.45am, widnes crem at 10.00am and then the Pavilions. He will be sadly missed by all.
