The minutes of the Halton & District Junior League meeting held at the Pavilions on 8th October 2009 at 8pm.

All clubs were in attendance except: Bridge Ath, St.Michaels, Team Oasis, Upton, Westgarth.

The chairman welcomed all to the meeting and asked had you all signed in and was there only 2 delegates per club.

1. **Minutes of the last meeting:** They were passed as true and correct.
- 1.1 **Matters arising:** Committee members are asked for if you want to nominate in writing yourself please do so but it is hard work and lots of time there will be a interview process.Also we need help for this years Germany trip to go ahead please all help out by maybe each club doing a raffle etc and donating money and all these kids who have been will tell you what a great experience for them so please make sure you all help out with this anyone who can fund raise please do so and contact myself or any committee member with your idea and hopefully you doing it.
2. **Finance:** Jane White told the floor there was £18,117.03p but deposits are included leaving £17,267.03p there was a question for Jane.The floor asked cant the league pay for the Germany trip or put in a big portion but the Treasurer explained that figure was for trophies at the end of the year and we as a League do fund part of it.
3. **Registrations:** Carole Gleave is no longer the Registration Secretary and we would like to say thanks to Carole for all her previous hard work and she will remain as a Committee Member.Mandy Mainwaring will be the new Registration Secretary,her address is 34 Mather Ave,Weston Point Runcorn 01928 573040 member, you can put the completed Registration forms and proof of birth etc through her door (Do not send them in the mail) up to 8pm at night any week day you do not need to phone or knock but you will only be allowed to collect on a Friday up till 8pm, but Mike said please call if there is a problem.
4. **Team sheet co-ordinators:** Jason Bate & Mike Galbraith: Jason for 11-aside said please only send teamsheets through the postal service do not come to his home, he has been a little lenient but as of tonight this will be stopped so please check sheets thoroughly, Julie told the floor if your Referee did not show up someone must be appointed between the 2 teams so please get them to sign it and try to put in brackets if they were a manger/parent etc and they are also entitled to the fee that is owed so please put the fee in and the person appointed has all powers of Referee and if anyone needs sending off or the line reporting they can do this . Mike for mini soccer also asked not to go his home with them only through postal service also, again a lot of mistakes,where it asks for League or cup it must have correct information in for League games for u7's write League, u8's Best Sports, u9's League, u10's Rocksavage Power League, pass this on to Managers as fines will be issued next week if this is missing,Check the teamsheets are going to correct co-ordinators and not the mistake that was on earlier teamsheets,it should be Mike is Mini and Jason is 11-aside.This was given out at the last meeting also.Julie reminded the floor the teamsheet must be done before the game commences not after.

- 4.2 **Charter League:** Dave Wilson & Julie Cole: Dave told the floor we should get the award very soon, we will be following FA guidelines and only showing scores at a maximum of 6,the FA are hoping to reduce the size of mini soccer and even encourage us to go to 9V9 for u11's so expect changes next year. We really want to start a girls League next season so please advertise this for us and see if you can start one yourselves, also Leagues may be reduced to no more than 10 in Leagues so there will be more divisions, we need to run a course for age appropriate as each club must have at least one manager who holds

this so please get your name down now as this is mandatory and you club will be expected to go on it..Clubs are being asked to put forward a child from each club to be a rep for meetings for the clubs and Leagues to talk to see what they feel would help them and their clubs.

5. **Mini soccer fixture Secretary:** had nothing to say.
6. **11 Aside fixtures Secretary & Web site:** Dave Wilson asked that if you want to witness draws stay at the end of meeting, send in match reports get them to him but please remember they must be fair, Dunlops asked do we monitor reports and we said yes we cant see all every week but Julie reminded the floor that the club will be responsible for their parents and managers comments so be careful. Dave said there is a good standard of football and he also asked can you be responsible for your own rubbish please take a bin bag and do the clean up. Do not keep jumping pitches only play on your own or if the League move you.
7. **Referee's Secretary:** David Seddon had nothing to say.
8. **Runcorn & District FA Rep:** Julie Cole said nothing to report .
9. **Correspondence:** Julie gave out to the floor the Handbooks are in folders all look at your details and say now if not correct there was a couple which Dave will send out on an amendment page soon.

Anyone in u11's this is vital information for you, the Halton School boys team is active this year and no one must play for the team in the morning then play for your League club later this is not allowed, this goes with regards to all football at any age, kids who may play in other Leagues who kick off earlier or later than us get caught out by this so often and to confirm this the following e-mail from county was read out to clarify this saying you must play only one game per day so if you play 5 mins in a school game/League game etc then that is declared a game so therefore you cannot play again that day this is for all age groups in this League.

Norton priory Museum have asked could we please be considerate whilst at Haddocks wood as we are obstructing their visitors and causing a hazard with parking.

A lot of Managers/Coaches are not wearing the ID badges this is a League rule so ensure they wear them. Only 2 people are allowed on the inside of the rope and both should be ID holders so don't have 2 plus the flag person.
