The chairman welcomed all to the meeting and asked had you all signed in and was there only 2 delegates per club.

4.2 Charter League: Dave Wilson & Julie Cole:Dave told the floor we have been awarded Charter League just waiting for the award,we will be following FA guidelines and only showing scores at a maximum of 9,the FA are hoping to reduce the size of mini soccer and even encourage us to go to 9V9 for u11's so expect changes next year.we really want to start a girls League next season so please advertise this for us and see if you can start one yourselves, also Leagues may be reduced to no more than 10 in Leagues so there will be more divisions,

7. 9. Still getting reports over spectators and some Mangaers not behaving and playing the game in good spirits, then when I ask for it in writing you are not willing to take it further but we cannot do anything unless its in writing, I will go and monitor as many games as I can but I cant do them all so please don't always phone and ask just for me, but if its got to that stage where a game needs monitoring please follow through with a complaint in writing or nothing will ever change.

10. A.O.B (Notification of which was made in writing at least 7 days prior to the meeting).Cronton Villa asked could Dave look at splitting the divisions next year to make the teams more compatible as they are struggling each weak with some of there teams getting beat by high scores,Dave Wilson explained firstly it depends on how many enter the League that year as to wether he can do more than one division but he will certainly look at it when its time.
