The minutes of the Halton & District Junior meeting held at Pavilions on 3rd March 2011 start 8pm.

All clubs in attendance except: Cromwell, Hurricanes, Sporting Rangers, Sutton Rangers, Team Oasis, Windmill Hill Dragons, Wolves .

The Chairman opened the meeting.

The clubs were asked to make sure they sign in and that a maximum of 2 delegates were present from each club.

Unfortunately James will be attending a later meeting as we still need more information from the council regarding government cuts etc.

1. Minutes of the last meeting passed by Runcorn Town & Pex Hill

1.1 Matters arising: It was pointed out by Dave Wilson the minutes should read Dave Seddon resigned from the role as Referee's Secretary due to work and this was noted.

2. Finance; Jane told the floor there is £11,573.31p, Of which £850 are club deposits. Leaving £10,723.31p there was no questions for the Treasurer. Jane asked to see Bridge Ath, Brookvale, Beechwood, Woolton, Read Park, Okell, Sporting Rangers at the end.

3. Registration Secretary: Mandy had nothing to report.

4. Teamsheets-Mini Soccer Jane had nothing to report, Jason had nothing to report.

4.1 Welfare Officers Jackie Feeley & Julie Cole: Nothing to report as meeting was cancelled due to CCFA having repair work.

4.2 Charter Standard Officer: Dave Wilson had nothing to report.

5. Mini Soccer Fixture Secretary: Mike Mainwaring had nothing to report .

6.11 Aside fixture Secretary & Web Site: Dave Wilson told the floor that sadly a young player who played for Okell and Woolton had died and the League had postponed Wooltons and Okell games this weekend and would all teams hold a minutes silence to show their respects, the League had already passed its condolences to the clubs. There will be cup draws after the meeting and asked for witnesses to remain. We are committed to progressing to 9v9 for the next seasons u11's and do have a meeting with the council and CCFA set up so will let you know.

Dave Wilson also informed all that the details are now input on the full time system that allows clubs and Referee's to get an email when allocated a game. Dave stated if the League call off games before a Saturday you don't need to send in teamsheet but if it gets to the Saturday you must, this caused some confusion as Hale asked what if its early and teams have not travelled yet or even your own kids are not there to sign?, Julie then took some more examples such as what if a Referee inspects it at 9am for the club, it was suggested if the 2 teams are not there and the home club can get the Referee to inspect pitch and stop the other team travelling don't need to send in teamsheet.

Julie then asked Dave if she can hand the next part to him as she wanted to clear something up regarding letting us know about games called off and Dave said with regards to phoning in results for games this also goes for a game that is called off/postponed by Referee say for frozen pitch/waterlogged etc, Hale said so we need to phone in to say game called off but don't need to send in teamsheet if opposition not there? she was told yes that's correct. Julie also pointed out the Referee is entitled to half of his fee for inspecting the pitch .

7. Referee's Secretary: It was given to the floor that Mike Mainwaring does not want to allocate mini soccer Referee's so David Seddon will be doing this up to the end of the season and Dave Wilson will do the 11 aside Referee's until the end of the season, James Hill has nominated himself to be assist Referee's secretary and Mike, Dave and David all sat and discussed this with him and has agreed to him assisting them.

Julie told the floor the recent Referee's meeting went well and some Referee's would like to state again clubs need to be aware of some bad lines, and they would report any as we wont tolerate this. Dave Wilson did say he will allocate Referee's to games and can depend on transport, age etc so please bear all this in mind.

Awaiting CCFA to tell us the maximum allowed to increase Referees fee's for next season but will have to go through as rule proposal for AGM.
